### DMin AT DALLAS AND SINGAPORE

Perkins School of Theology at Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas, USA, and Trinity Theological College of Singapore will begin the eighth year of the DMin program at Trinity in July 2017.

The DMin provides the opportunity to enhance pastoral practice, while helping Christian leaders integrate understanding and skills into a theologically reflective practice of ministry. Perkins offers emphasis in six areas:

- Evangelism
- Pastoral Leadership
- Preaching and Worship
- Missional Church Studies
- Spiritual Formation
- Urban Ministry

The first two-week session will be conducted at Trinity July 19 - 30, 2017. Entering students will travel to the United States once to Perkins in Dallas in January 2018 and may complete the degree as early as 2019 with courses at Trinity and through distance education.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Professional leadership responsibilities in a ministry setting.
- An approved MDiv degree or equivalent with a cumulative grade-point average of 3.0/4.0.
- Experience and competence in ministry, normally within a minimum of three years of fulltime experience following completion of the MDiv.
- Essays addressing the proposed area for study.
