 There must be room left in your Fall "package" for an award, or you could consider decreasing some loan amount if you qualify for some funds from the Harrison scholarship.

S Undergraduates and graduate students can be considered for this award, but you must be a student at SMU in Fall 2020.

If you would like to be considered for some small award from this scholarship (multiple students may be awarded), please submit the following:

Write a one-page essay about why you are deserving of this scholarship, describing any financial need, as well as how your disability impacts you in a way that leads you to need this scholarship.
