Construction Update

Owen Arts Center is undergoing a major renovation. Some of the entrances are closed, and the map on the right identifies the entrances of the building.

For F2020 semester, we recommend individuals with mobility impairments use the west (Hillcrest) entrance. It has a ramp and an automatic door opener.

For Spr2021, the south entrance will be the only available entrance with a ramp. However, there is no automatic door opener at this entrance. UNDER
