#### Jan Term Letters

If you are enrolled for Jan Term 2021, due to the fast-paced mini-term, it is important to have your letters and accommodations in place sooner than later.

Classes will begin on January 7th and having your letters requested and delivered ahead of time will help you stay on track. A few courses (language courses and Organic Chemistry 1) take place over an extended schedule beginning December 17.

A semester request should be submitted very early to ensure it can be processed before the holiday break when offices are closed from December 21st until January 3rd, and then FOLLOW UP with your professor to discuss implementing the accommodations.

#### **Finals Reminder**

**NOW** is the time to check the dates of your final exams. Your final exam should be taken when your class is scheduled to test. Usually the test date is in your instructors syllabus. The university's fall finals schedule can be located on the Registrar's website.

**YOU** should have contacted your professors to confirm your testing accommodations and any time conflicts you might have. Don't expect your professor to remember that you are using your accommodations. It is your Responsibility to contact them well before your test date. (Dedman Law students should contact Dean Yeager's office or Kim Grace).

### **Spring Letters**



Spring 2021 classes begin January 25th

The best time to submit a semester request is 2 weeks before classes begin. This allows for any class changes that may have been made (by you) so your letter will be up to date.

Once you are notified your letter has been shared with your professors successfully through DASS Link, you should make plans to meet with them during office hours (skipping this step means your accommodations are NOT finalized). Ideally, this happens the first two weeks of classes. Document the plans you two make in writing so there is no confusion later.
