Now is a good time to start thinking about your summer and fall classes as registration is right around the corner. Schedule to meet with your advisor ASAP and clear any holds in my.SMU so you're ready for your Enrollment Appointment-which can be found in my.SMU. If you have test-taking accommodations, keep in mind how that might impact the arrangement of your classes in a day. Building in breaks between classes is advisable, if possible. This minimizes the need to reschedule tests for those with extended time. Contacting your professor at least one week before the exam will allow time to resolve any conflict you or maybe professor may have in administering extra time to your test if approved for this. Sharing your schedule with your professor will help you discuss your testing conflicts.
