Thank you for forwarding the resolution in support of non-binary and transgender members of the SMU community passed by the Faculty Senate on March 3, 2022. SMU reaffirms its support with the following statement:

Consistent with the University's longstanding nondiscrimination policy which includes nondiscrimination on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity and expression, we affirm that SMU will remain a place where our LGBTQ+ community, who identify as transgender, can work, learn, teach, and thrive in the safety afforded to all members of SMU.
