Dear SMU Community,

We are enhancing campus safety with new manual door locks in classrooms and related workspaces that currently cannot be locked from the inside without a key. These new locks will empower students, faculty, staff and guests to secure a room without the need for a key in the event of an emergency.

Facilities Management is coordinating the lock installation with designated building managers to minimize any disruption to nearby classrooms and offices. You may have noticed these locking devices in some buildings already such as Hyer, Storey, Heroy, Kirby, Prothro and Dallas Halls. <u>Instructions on how to work the device can be found here</u>.

Please note this locking device will not work for glass doors so it is important that you learn more about <u>preparing for an active threat</u> on the <u>SMU Aware website</u>.
