Minimum Qualifications

- Maintain a 2.5 SMU semester and cumulative GPA
- Must be in good standing with the University (not on any academic or disciplinary probation or suspension)
- Willing to live in the Residential Commons/community that you serve while in this position
- Committed to working on Peer Dialogue Leaders projects at least 2-3 hours/week

Role Description & Expectations

2018-2019 Academic Year

- Move in August 2018 (most likely Aug. 9th)
- Attend training on: August 10-11
- Attend Residence Life Leadership Team Training (most likely Aug. 13-14th)
- Serve as part of the Leadership Team in your Commons, this includes communicating with RCD on a regular basis
- Attend regular PDL meetings fall and spring semesters (1-2 per semester)
- Participate in on-going leadership and facilitation training
- Be available for personal consultations from residents, resident assistants and other peer leader staff members regarding diversity and inclusion topics in your community.
- Implement two (2) programs per semester (or as needed – determined RCD & OMSA staff)
- Meet with Residential Commons & Office of Multicultural Student Affairs staff as needed
