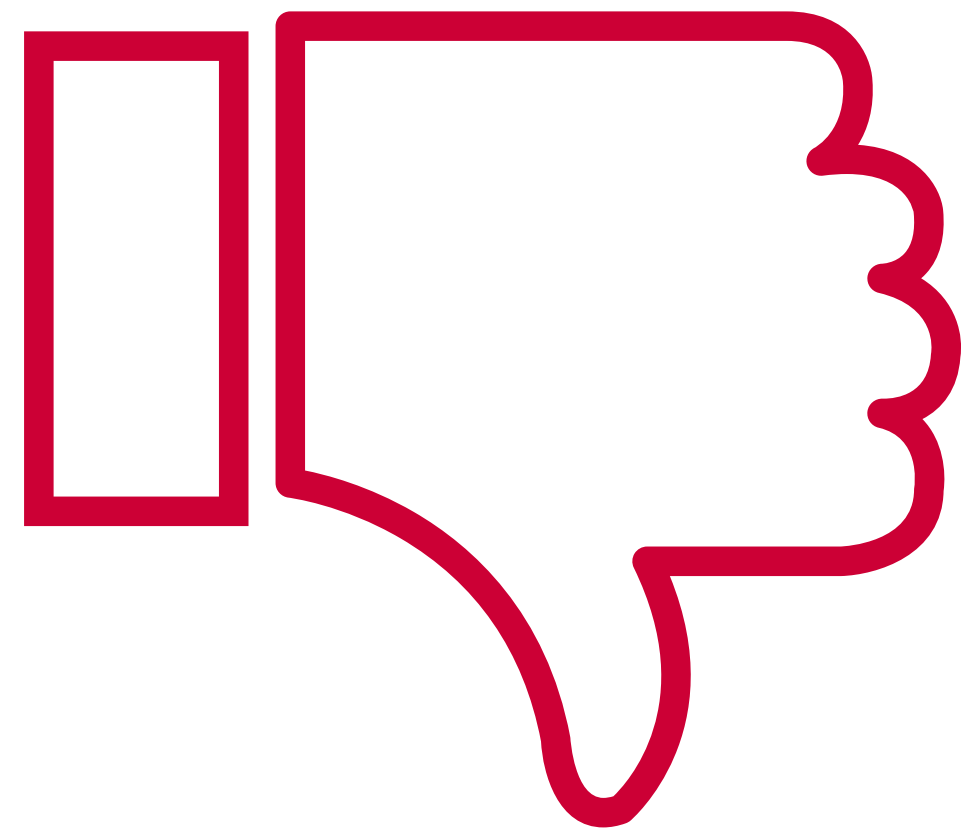


HAZING

HAZING MEANS ANY INTENTIONAL KNOWING, OR **RECKLESS ACT**, OCCURRING ON OR OFF THE CAMPUS BY ONE PERSON ALONE OR ACTING WITH OTHERS, DIRECTED AGAINST A STUDENT, THAT **ENDANGERS** THE MENTAL OR PHYSICAL **HEALTH OR SAFETY** OF A STUDENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLEDGING, BEING INITIATED INTO, AFFILIATING WITH, HOLDING OFFICE IN, OR MAINTAINING **MEMBERSHIP** IN ANY ORGANIZATION WHOSE MEMBERS ARE OR INCLUDE, STUDENTS.
