Young Jack did not appear to be anything special to friends and family. Of course they loved him because he was family, but few would say they saw early signs of wisdom in the child.

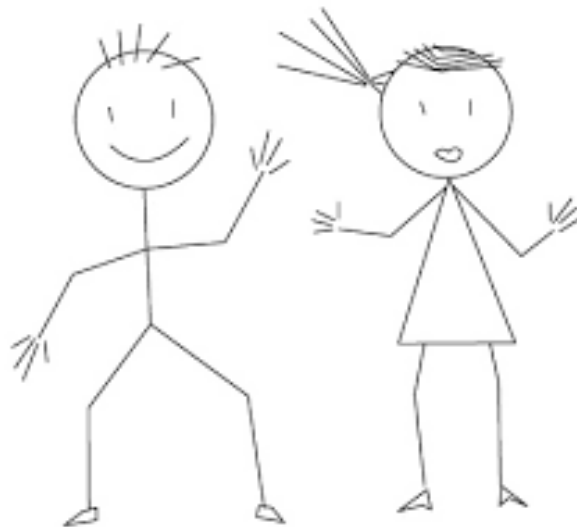


Figure 1.1. An early piece of artwork by Jack Handey, age 17
