The United States has restrictive laws regarding payments made to non-U.S. Citizens. Therefore, it is necessary that you enter the United States in a nor immigrant classification that allows Southern Methodist University to pay you your honorarium.
If you are from a country that is part of the Visa Waiver Program (VWP), you do not need a vis to enter the United States, but you must have authorization through the electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) prior to your travel. Upon arrival in the United States, you should specifically request WB (waiver for business) classification at the port of entry. For informatio about the VWP and ESTA, visit the State Department website.
If your country is not part of the Visa Waiver Program, you will need to obtain a B-1/B-2 visa from the U.S. Consulate (or use an unexpired B-1/B-2 visa already stamped in your passport if

from the U.S. Consulate (or use an unexpired B-1/B-2 visa already stamped in your passport if applicable) and request to be admitted as a B-1 (visitor for business) upon your entry into the United States.

These two classifications (WB & B-1) allow you to receive honoraria and allow the reimbursement of travel related expenses. Please note that if you enter the United States in B-2 or WT (waiver for tourism) status then Southern Methodist University will be unable to pay your honorarium and/or reimburse your expenses.
