
Write with Clarity: Academic Writing Workshop Series


Speaking Coach

- Due to the time limit, the tutor may not review more than 15 pages in a session.



Writing counselors can help you with...

- selecting the appropriate wording/phrasing
- Identifying patterns of errors in grammar and punctuation
- Producing greater sentence variety
- Providing self-editing tips
- Structure, organization, and information flow
- Sources or cited literature
- Formality, tone, and voice of an essay

- Following up on the consultation session, reread your essay and rewrite it as suggested.
- If necessary, you can schedule another consultation meeting with a revised draft.
- It is highly recommended to narrow down to a few discussion points to get help from the consultation.


