This foundational course offers students a journey through the historical and philosophical roots of nonprofit organizations and their connection to arts and related contexts over time.

Explores nonprofit rationale, leadership principles, and potential for social impact within the broader landscape of nonprofit organizations in the United States.

**ANPL 6305 - Financial Stewardship in Nonprofit Organizations. Credits: 3**

Provides applied acumen in financial management practices tailored to nonprofit organizations including accounting, budgeting, analysis, reporting, and revenue/expense management strategies, with emphasis on transparency and accountability, including case studies and project applications. Prerequisite or corequisite: ANPL 6300.
