Process changes for extra compensation requests. What this means for chairs, associate deans, and deans: on the faculty side, department chairs will need to look for Extra Compensation Approval Requests in their email on a regular basis. You will also need to alert staff who serve as supervisors to check their approval requests regularly. All department coordinators and executive assistants who attended the November 20th Administrative Support Staff workshop (over 50 in attendance!) have been trained on how to add the immediate supervisor.
