STARTING COLLEGE CAN FEEL OVERWHELMING, ESPECIALLY WHEN YOU'RE NAVIGATING SOCIAL, SENSORY, AND HISTORICAL ACADEMIC SYSTEMS THAT WEREN'T DESIGNED WITH YOU IN MIND. THAT'S WHY DISABILITY ACCOMMODATIONS AND SUCCESS STRATEGIES (DASS) CREATED A NEW AUTISM RESOURCE WEBSITE WHICH WAS SHAPED DIRECTLY BY INTERVIEWS WITH SMU STUDENTS WITH AUTISM.

Support Area	Do	Don't
Academic Strategy	✓ Use weekly and semester planners ✓ Try tutoring, study groups, and note- taking tools	<ul> <li>Don't assume high school success = college readiness</li> <li>Don't underestimate college workload</li> </ul>
Social & Emotional Life	✓ Attend community events ✓ Use roommate matching ✓ Join groups	<ul><li>X Don't isolate</li><li>X Don't feel pressure to socialize too much</li></ul>
Sensory & Environment	✓ Communicate about sensory needs early (fire drills, noise, food options) ✓ Use quiet study spots and fidget tools	<ul> <li>Don't avoid dining solutions explore options</li> <li>Don't wait to ask about accommodations</li> </ul>

Mental Health & Self-Care	✓ Use peer mentoring as a low-pressure support option ✓ Schedule downtime and stick to routines	<ul><li>X Don't overcommit</li><li>X Don't ignore early signs of burnout</li></ul>
