📌 Helpful Reminders

- Check your specific building's amenities list before purchasing anything — some include full kitchens, furnished living rooms, or private bathrooms.
- Coordinate with your roommates if you're planning to bring shared items.

Leave at Home

Fire Hazards - these items violate safety regulations

- Non-UL approved electric devices, extension cords without switches
- X) Candles, incense, reed diffusers
- Halogen and incandescent light bulbs (only bring LED lightbulbs)
- Electric scooters, bikes, hoover boards
- (X) In units without kitchens, the following appliances are prohibited: toasters, toaster ovens, broilers, electric skillets, grills, slow cookers, and hot plates.
- In units with kitchens, the following appliances are prohibited: additional refrigerators, grills, deep fryers, extra microwaves, and any appliances not UL-approved.
- Anything that requires screws or nails to adhere to the wall (use push pin instead -10 or less per room)
- Pets (although residents are allowed fishes in an 10 gallon or less fish tank)
- Command strips or LED light strips or removeable wallpapers that use adhesives to stick to walls (use blue painters tape, sticky tack instead)
