

Testing Protocol at DASS

- Testing time and day MUST be confirmed with your professor BEFORE a test is scheduled at DASS.
- If the day and time is different from the class, you MUST get permission from your instructor FIRST before you schedule.
- Then book your test in DASS Link.
 Schedule your test at LEAST 7 days out from the date of your test.
- Show up at the time you have scheduled to take your test. If you are late, you don't get that test time back.
- 20 minutes late, you may be sent back to your instructor to test
- Why? Concerns over testing security and proctor coverage.
