Dates to schedule finals:

NOV 1-DEC 3 2019

Final exams may not be booked before or after these dates.

Before a final exam is scheduled at DASS, meet and discuss the testing arrangement with your professor. Test with your professor, if possible.

If your professor needs you to test at DASS, log in to your DASS Link portal; https://smu-

testing times for finals have 3 start times to

accommodate your extra time. 9-1:30; 11:30-4; 2:30 -7.

On Saturday, there is only a 9-1:30 time section.

Students with double time can only schedule at the 9 am and 11:30 start times.

DASS Link Test Scheduling Tip!

Forgot what time you scheduled your test? Your approved and pending test bookings will be found on the Test Proctoring page in your DASS Link Portal.

Your exams should be **scheduled as close to the time of your class final**. If you schedule a final that is not the same day and general time as the class, DASS will need the professor to approve the time/date change. The communication of the change must sent to dass@smu.edu for confirmation. Find out how long the class will receive for the final. For any finals that are less than 3 hours, please let DASS know so we can adjust any extended time appropriately.

There is limited seating in our testing rooms. Due to these limitations it is important for students to arrange for their exam at DASS as early as possible. If the room is full at your needed time, you either need to arrange for the test elsewhere or get permission to take your final at an alternate time from your professor. Avoid this by booking EARLY!

Cox students and grad students might make arrangements within the department— see your professor ASAP for guidance. It is not required to take your final at DASS.
