
REGISTRATION FOR FALL AND SUMMER BEGINS SOON

The Registrar's office is working diligently to assign times for the upcoming registration period: enrollment for continuing students will be April 4th-15th, and open enrollment begins April 23rd. You should be able to see the earliest time you may register posted in Access on March 22nd. Meanwhile, remember to schedule an appointment with your advisor ASAP in order to plan your schedule for the Fall and/or Summer semesters. Check for and clear any holds on your registration. Don't wait for the last minute to discover you have a hold! When picking classes and professors, consider what you've learned about yourself:

- ⇒ Do you put your toughest classes in the morning since you have the most energy in the a.m.?
- ⇒ How do you handle breaks...are they good or bad?
- ⇒ How can you balance the reading load?
