
You can't make up the time if you arrive AFTER your scheduled time to test.

How the KIC scanner in Fondren Library can help you



For students with learning disabilities, visual impairments, or even attention issues, it can be helpful to get your reading material into an e-version in order to listen to it. The very fancy KIC scanner in Fondren Library can help! Scan documents quickly, save them as higher quality and as a searchable PDF so Kurzweil or another screenreader can easily read them. You can even select to save the document as an audio file! It comes to your email as an mp3 computergenerated voice reading the page...amazing! There are KIC scanners in Hamon and **Bridwell** libraries too. Talk to a DASS staff person or a librarian for more information.
