If your professor wants you to test at DASS for finals, **LISTEN UP!** You need to schedule the final using our Online Scheduler as soon as possible. If you need to take the final at a different time than the class (only for valid reasons), you **MUST** get written permission from your professor and forward the email to **DASS**.
