Kevin R. Mandia became president of FireEye, a leader in cyber security, in February 2015. He has spent nearly 20 years in information security, beginning in the military as a computer security officer at the Pentagon. In 2004 he founded Mandiant Corporation, computer consulting services, and served as its CEO and president. Before forming Mandiant, he built the computer forensics and investigations group at Foundstone computer security services from its infancy to a global practice.

Mandia has developed specialized classes for the Federal Bureau of Investigation and other government agencies. He has trained hundreds of attorneys in the technical aspects of computer forensics and teaches courses at The George Washington University. He is co-author of two books: *Incident Response: Performing Computer Forensics* and *Incident Response: Investigating Computer Crime*.

Mandia earned a B.S. in computer science from Lafayette College and the M.S. in forensic science from The George Washington University.
