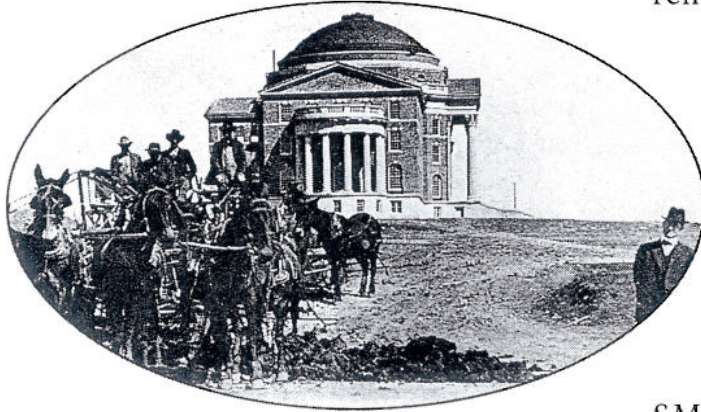

SOUTHERN METHODIST UNIVERSITY

In 1911, a Methodist education commission made a commitment to establish a major Methodist university in Texas. More than 600 acres of open prairie and \$300,000 pledged by a group of Dallas citizens secured the university for Dallas, and it was chartered as Southern Methodist University. In appreciation of the city's support, the first building to be constructed on the campus was named Dallas Hall. It



remains the centerpiece and symbol of SMU. When the University opened in 1915, it consisted of two buildings, 706 students, a 35-member faculty, and total assets of \$636,540. The original schools of

SMU were the College of Arts and Sciences, the School of Theology, and the School of Music.

SMU is owned by the South Central Jurisdiction of the United Methodist Church. The first charge of its founders, however, was that it become a great university, not necessarily a great Methodist university. From its founding, SMU has been nonsectarian in its teaching and committed to the values of academic freedom and open inquiry.

SMU also has maintained a strong partnership with Dallas and has given special consideration to area needs in the development of academic programs. In the 1920s, the first business curriculum was offered in response to a request by the Dallas Chamber of Commerce; the Dallas Bar Association supported establishment of the law school; and a forerunner of the engineering school was established with encouragement from the Dallas Technical Club.

After struggling through its early years and the Depression of the 1930s, SMU experienced a surge of growth after World War II. From the late 1940s to the end of the

1960s, more than half of the current buildings on campus were constructed. SMU's academic stature took on a new dimension when the first Ph.D. programs were instituted in 1957.

Today, Southern Methodist University offers a comprehensive curriculum through Dedman College – the college of humanities and sciences – and five schools: Meadows School of the Arts, Edwin L. Cox School of Business, School of Engineering and Applied Science, Perkins School of Theology, and School of Law.

The University offers 68 undergraduate majors, Master's degrees in 42 areas, professional degrees in 16 disciplines, and Ph.D. degrees in 17 fields.

Enrollment for the 1995-96 academic year was 9,172, including 5,297 undergraduate students and 3,875 graduate and professional school students. SMU students come from all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and 95 nations. Over 70 percent of undergraduate students received some form of financial aid in 1995-96. Almost 19 percent of undergraduate students are members of racial minority groups. Twenty percent of the total student body is United Methodist, 19 percent Roman Catholic. Also represented in the student body are other Protestant denominations and other religions, including Judaism, Greek Orthodox, and Islam.

In addition to preparing students for graduate and professional schools, or more directly for their life's work, the University strives to enhance their social, moral, intellectual, and religious development so that they may lead worthy lives as individuals and citizens of the nation and of the world.



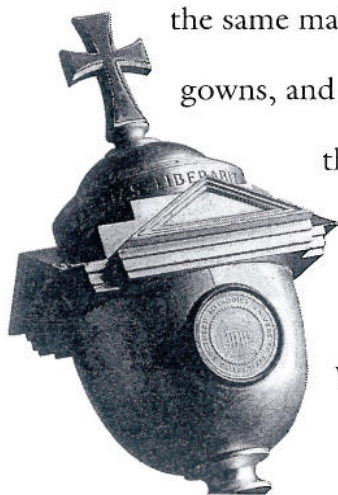
THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION AND REGALIA

The academic procession and the regalia worn by the faculty and officers of the University symbolically represent the continuing link between the modern American university and the founding of the great medieval universities in Europe — chief among them Bologna, Paris, and Oxford. As those institutions were derived from the Catholic Church, the universities adopted many of the ceremonial trappings of the church in their official public functions.

The mace of the University, a symbol of the authority vested in the president by the Board of Trustees and representing the covenant between the president and the faculty, is borne by the president of the Faculty Senate. Though the order of the procession varies from university to university, at Southern Methodist University it proceeds from the chief marshal through the ranks of the faculty and the officers of the University, to the president, who is preceded by the mace-bearer.

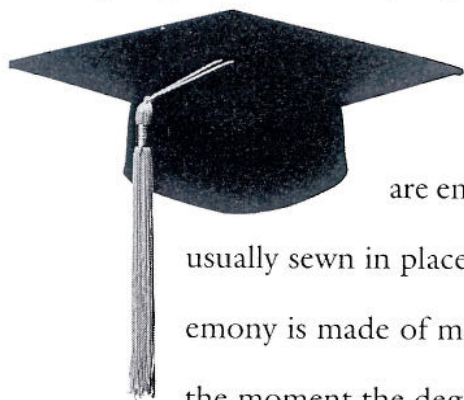
The caps and gowns worn in the procession also vary from place to place. There are variations in design to indicate the degrees held by the wearers, and many universities in America have introduced colorful gowns and other distinguishing details (in place of the customary clerical black from which all originated). The bachelor's gown is a simple robe falling in straight lines from an elaborate yoke. Its distinguishing characteristic is the long pointed sleeves. Master's gowns are arranged so that the arm emerges from a long sleeve through a slit at the wrist (replacing a former slit at the elbow). In most cases, the doctor's gown is marked by velvet panels down the front and around the neck, and by three bars of

the same material on the bell-shaped sleeves. It is cut much fuller than the other gowns, and may be ornamented in color. Faculty colors are occasionally seen in the sleeve bars and paneling.



The caps, too, vary according to the customs of the university from which the wearer received a degree. While most American universities adopted the “mortarboard” style of Oxford, others have

chosen styles based on other European institutions. The color of the tassel worn with the cap may be black for any degree; or, the color may be that of the faculty of the major field



of learning (e.g. Arts, Engineering, Law, etc.). Persons holding doctoral degrees and governing officials of institutions are entitled to wear tassels of gold metallic thread. Such tassels are usually sewn in place. It is common practice, although not universal, that a ceremony is made of moving the tassel from the right to the left side of the cap at the moment the degree is awarded.

Within the great varieties of styles and colors in gowns and caps, there has been one universally accepted code for the hood worn trailing down the wearer's back. Originally, it was like the hood on the habit worn by monks. Nowadays, the hood through length and color shows the degree and the specialization of the wearer, and the university that granted the degree. The Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctor's hoods are 3 feet, 3 1/2 feet, and 4 feet long, respectively. The velvet trimming in the same order is 2, 3, and 5 inches wide. The color of the trim identifies the faculty. A partial list of faculty colors follows: Arts, Letters, Humanities – White; Music – Pink; Business – Drab; Philosophy – Dark Blue; Engineering – Orange; Science – Golden Yellow; Fine Arts – Brown; Theology – Scarlet; Law – Purple. The lining of the hood — that portion most visible from the rear — indicates the institution awarding the degree. SMU's hood lining, for example, is blue with a red chevron.

Through these colorful ceremonies, SMU symbolically displays the continuity of its educational purposes with the origins of organized learning in the Western world.

RETIRING FACULTY

ROBERT T. ANDERSON

Robert Anderson has been a professor of organ and sacred music in the Division of Music since 1960. He received a Baccalaureate degree from Illinois Wesleyan University and the Master's and Doctor of Sacred Music degrees from Union Theological Seminary. He completed two years of additional studies as a Fulbright Scholar in Germany. At SMU he was selected in 1981 as the first Meadows Foundation Distinguished Teaching Professor and was named a University Distinguished Professor in 1983. Professor Anderson is internationally known as a concert artist, recording artist, competition judge, leader of workshops and master classes, and teacher. He has performed and held master classes throughout the United States, Japan, and Europe. He has been a consultant for numerous organ installations in the United States, and was instrumental in the design and installation of the Fisk 101 organ in SMU's Caruth Auditorium. His students have been winners and finalists in many prestigious regional, national, and international organ competitions. He organized a two-year series of concerts on the Fisk 101 organ that featured among the most prominent of his former students. He has held leadership positions in the American Guild of Organists at the regional and national levels and recently was appointed chair of the jury for the First Triennial International Organ Competition sponsored by the Dallas Symphony Orchestra. Professor Anderson has served SMU as the University chapel organist, acting director of chapel music, and on numerous committees. He will retire as University Distinguished Professor *Emeritus* of Music.

FRANKLIN G. BALCH III

Franklin G. Balch III, professor of political science, earned a Bachelor's degree in European history from Harvard University, a Master of Arts degree in foreign affairs from the University of Virginia, and M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in American diplomatic history from Tuft's University's Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy. He joined the SMU faculty in 1966 as an associate professor in government. Deeply committed to his students and actively involved in a wide range of student activities, Professor Balch has received numerous honors from the SMU student body in recognition of his exceptional teaching and contributions to the University community. Among these are three Rotunda Outstanding Professor awards, the James K. Wilson Outstanding Professor award, SMU's prestigious "M" award, the Panhellenic and Intrafraternity Council Award for Excellence in Teaching, the Alpha Tau Omega Teacher Appreciation Award, and selection as Outstanding Professor of the Year by SMU's first-year honorary societies. During his tenure at SMU, he served his faculty colleagues in numerous capacities, including as chair of the Department of Political Science, director of undergraduate studies in political science, vice president of the Faculty Senate, chair of the Presidential Scholars Search Committee, and membership on numerous committees and task force groups. Before joining SMU, Professor Balch held several administrative positions, including assistant dean of students at Harvard University, director of the Honors College at Wesleyan University, and assistant to the director of the Harvard International Seminar. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of political science.

KAY BETHUNE

Kay Bethune, assistant professor of English, received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Tulane University's Newcomb College and a Master of Arts degree from Southern Methodist University. While completing her Master's degree, she was a Teaching Fellow; she joined the SMU faculty on a full-time basis as an instructor in fall 1965. Professor Bethune served as director of Freshman Writing from 1982 until 1986 and contributed to the University community through service on numerous departmental

and Universitywide committees. In addition to her undergraduate courses in fiction, poetry, freshman composition, and women writers, she taught in SMU's Master of Liberal Arts program and the University's Upward Bound program. Professor Bethune participated in SMU's Women's Studies program and has been active in women's issues during her career. She also has served as an adviser in the University's Teacher Preparation program and as a consultant for the Plano High School English Department. She will retire as assistant professor *emerita* of English.

JAMES BROWN

James Brown, professor of political science and the Ora Nixon Arnold Research Fellow in American Statesmanship and Diplomacy, received his Ph.D. degree from the State University of New York at Buffalo after the completion of Bachelor's and Master's degrees at Texas Christian University. He joined the SMU faculty as an instructor in 1962. His teaching and research interests include American politics with an emphasis on national security affairs, the legislative process, and political parties and voting behavior. Professor Brown's research has been supported in part by grants from the U.S. Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency, the Department of Defense, and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's Ames Laboratory. He has written or edited eight books and monographs and more than 30 articles. He organized a series of highly regarded conferences on arms control issues, which drew scholars, government and industrial leaders, and military officials from 30 nations. A Fellow of the Royal United Services Institute for Defense Studies, Professor Brown has served as special assistant to the director and foreign affairs specialist of the U.S. Arms Control and Disarmament Agency and special assistant to the deputy undersecretary of defense for planning and resources. He was instrumental in the creation and development of SMU's John Goodwin Tower Center for Political Studies, which prepares SMU undergraduates for careers in public service, and served as the center's first director.

WILLIAM COOPER

William Cooper joined the piano faculty of the Division of Music in 1961 and has served as an accompanist, vocal coach, and coordinator of the accompanying program. He studied with Nadia Boulanger at the L'École d'Art Américains in Fontainebleau, France. He received a Bachelor of Science degree from The Juilliard School of Music, a Master of Music from Southern Methodist University, and a Doctor of Musical Arts in Piano Performance from the University of Colorado. Professor Cooper performs regularly as an accompanist as well as with vocalists throughout the Southwest. He has appeared in numerous solo recitals and with orchestras in the Dallas area and throughout the country. Through his listing with Sol Hurok and Columbia Artists, he has performed with some of the greatest Metropolitan Opera singers, including Jan Peerce and Elinor Ross. Professor Cooper is known nationally through his appearances and his participation in the National Association of Teachers of Singing and the National Opera Association.

HARRIS CROHN

Harris Crohn has been a member of the piano faculty of the Division of Music since 1969. He received his Bachelor's and Master's of Music degrees from The Juilliard School of Music and his Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the Eastman School of Music. Before joining SMU, Professor Crohn taught at the University of Texas, the University of Southern Mississippi, and Del Mar College. His performance activities include numerous solo and chamber music recitals throughout the United States. Professor

Crohn was active in the formation and development of SMU's Artist Certificate program, for which he recruited more than a dozen students from the Czech Republic. Recently, several of his students won international competitions, and one was a contender in the Van Cliburn Competition and more recently in the Rubinstein Competition in Israel. Other students include a piano duo who appeared with the Dallas Symphony Orchestra in March and who will present a recital in the prestigious Van Cliburn Recital Series in Fort Worth. He will retire as associate professor *emeritus* of music.

PETER MOLLENHAUER

Peter Mollenhauer, associate professor of German, joined the SMU faculty in 1967 as chair of the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures after serving as assistant professor at the University of Wisconsin at Madison. He earned B.A. and Ph.D. degrees at the University of Texas at Austin. Professor Mollenhauer is the author of one monograph and co-author of one book and has written and translated numerous scholarly articles and book reviews. His teaching and research interests include Goethe, the Enlightenment, Klassik, and commercial German, and he has presented his work at conferences of the South Central Modern Language Association, the New England Modern Language Association, and the South Central Society for Eighteenth-Century Studies. Professor Mollenhauer led his colleagues as department chair for five years and as chair of the German area for another 11 years. He has served as director of the SMU-in-Austria program since 1976 and as consulting editor of *Schatzkammer für deutsche Sprachlehre und Dichtung* since 1973. He will retire as associate professor *emeritus* of German.

JIM MORRIS

Jim R. Morris received his Ed.D. in psychology and educational administration from the University of North Texas in 1969, his M.A. in journalism from the University of Georgia in 1964, and his B.J. in journalism from the University of Texas in 1959. After a decade at Kansas State University, where he was director of student publications and head of the journalism sequence, he joined SMU as head of the Advertising Department. He has served on the Faculty Senate and on the Curriculum Committee of the Center for Communication Arts, and he has been active in the American Academy of Advertising. He was instrumental in launching SMU's Communications Program in London, which meets each summer. He will retire as associate professor *emeritus* of communications.

G. DONALD PASQUELLA

Donald Pasquella has served as a faculty member at SMU since 1970. He received his B.S. in Electrical Engineering from the University of Oklahoma in 1959, and his M.A. in Speech and Dramatic Art (Cinema) from the University of Iowa in 1968. Before joining SMU, Professor Pasquella worked as a freelance photographer in Paris, was head of production for a large multimedia group in Connecticut, and taught film production at the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston. In 1970 he joined SMU in what was then the Broadcast/Film Division of the Meadows School of the Arts. He became chair of the Video and Cinema Division before its merger with Journalism to form the Center for Communication Arts in 1982. He has served on the Faculty Senate, as well as remained active in his field. He has produced short films and documentaries, and in recent years has begun making ambient videos. He will retire as associate professor *emeritus* of communications.

KLAUS PENZEL

Native of Germany, Professor Penzel joined the faculty of SMU's Perkins School of Theology in 1962. He studied theology at the Universities of Göttingen, Zurich, and Heidelberg before coming to the United States. He received his S.T.M. *magna cum laude* in 1954 and his Th.D. in 1962 from Union Theological Seminary in New York. In 1964 he was ordained in the Lutheran Church of America. During his three decades with the SMU faculty, he has devoted much of his teaching and research to the history of American Christianity and has published extensively on the 19th-century church historian Philip Schaff. He is widely respected as a dedicated teacher, and he has contributed greatly to the life and work of the School of Theology by chairing and serving on numerous faculty committees. During his career, he has been active in the American Academy of Religion, the American Catholic Historical Association, the American Historical Association, and especially the American Society of Church History. He retired December 31, 1995, as professor *emeritus* of church history.

FRANKLIN SOGANDARES-BERNAL

Franklin Sogandares-Bernal, professor of biological sciences, earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Tulane University and M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Nebraska. Before joining SMU, he held faculty appointments at Tulane and the University of Montana. While at Tulane he served as coordinator for science planning for the Natural Sciences and Mathematics, director of Graduate Studies and director of the Laboratory for Parasitology, and at the University of Montana as chair of Zoology. He joined SMU's Department of Biology in 1974 and served as chair of the department for two years. The author or co-author of 80 articles, his teaching and research interests include parasitology, infectious diseases, immunology, and pathology. His research has been funded in part by grants from the National Science Foundation, the National Institutes of Health, and other sources. In addition, Professor Sogandares-Bernal has served as a medical staff affiliate of the Department of Pathology at Baylor University Medical Center in Dallas and as assistant to the associate dean for Continuing Education at the University of Texas Health Science Center in Dallas. He was elected vice president and president of the Southwestern Association of Parasitologists, served on the editorial boards of *Journal of Parasitology* and *American Midland Naturalist*, and is a recipient of the Henry Baldwin Ward Medal from the American Society of Parasitologists. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of biological sciences.

HERBERT C. TURRENTINE

Herbert Turrentine joined the faculty of the Division of Music in 1967 and chaired the Department of Music History from 1969 to 1995. He received his Bachelor of Music Education from the University of Wichita, his Master's degree from Columbia University, and his Doctorate in Musicology from the University of Iowa. Before joining SMU, Professor Turrentine was a bassoonist for the Buffalo Philharmonic and held positions as instrumental music instructor for the Topeka Public Schools and as associate professor of music history and theory at Illinois State University. Professor Turrentine was co-chair of the Music Department in 1975-76; acting chair of the Summer Session in 1975; chair of Graduate Studies, 1969-73; and director of the Humanities Labs for University College, 1967-79. He has served as an adviser for graduate and undergraduate programs in music history throughout his tenure and also has served on numerous committees at the University and departmental levels. In 1985-86 he was selected as one of the "Most Popular Faculty for the Academic Year" by the SMU student body. In 1993 he was named the Meadows Distinguished Teaching Professor in recognition of his sustained and distinguished accomplishment. Professor Turrentine has been a member of the American Musicological Society for 35

years and a member of the Renaissance Society of America for 15 years. He has published articles in *Musical Quarterly*, *American Music Teacher*, *American Guild of Organists*, and the *Bulletin of the National Association of College Wind and Percussion Instructors*, as well as in the *New Grove's Dictionary of Music and Musicians*. His primary areas of research are music iconography and the Burgundian period. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of music history and literature.

JAMES A. WHARTON

Born to missionary parents in the Belgian Congo (now Zaire), Professor Wharton earned his B.A. in 1948 from the University of Texas in Austin and his B.D. in 1951 from Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary. He did his doctoral study at the University of Basel in Old Testament, receiving his Th.D. in 1968. From 1956 to 1975, he was a faculty member of Austin Presbyterian Seminary, resigning his position to become senior pastor of Memorial Drive Presbyterian Church in Houston. In 1985 Professor Wharton was appointed to the Lois Craddock Perkins Chair of Homiletics in SMU's Perkins School of Theology. As a teacher of preaching, he has served the Perkins community joyfully, especially in the area of worship. He is a member of the Society for Biblical Literature and of the American Academy of Religion. He has published articles in *Interpretation*, *Journal for Preachers*, and *The Presbyterian Outlook*, and has traveled for lecturing, speaking, and preaching engagements throughout the country. He will retire as Lois Craddock Perkins Professor *Emeritus* of Homiletics.

BACCALAUREATE PREACHER

WILLIAM M. FINNIN, JR.

William M. Finnin, Jr., a native of New Orleans, was appointed Chaplain and Preacher to the University at SMU in 1980. He earned a B.S. degree *cum laude* from Centenary College of Louisiana, a Master of Divinity degree *summa cum laude* from The Divinity School at Duke University, and a Doctor of Theology degree in the field of ethics and social sciences from The Iliff School of Theology at the University of Denver. He has taught for six years in SMU's Edwin L. Cox School of Business, has led seminar classes at Perkins School of Theology, and leads seminars on the works of novelist Walker Percy through SMU's Division of Evening and Summer Studies. In 1981 Dr. Finnin founded The United Methodist Campus Ministry and SMU's annual *Yom HaShoah* commemoration of the Holocaust. In 1984 he co-founded SMU's Alternative Spring Break Program and in 1991 SMU's Inter-Community Experience program, chairing its board of directors for two years. In addition to serving as the regular preacher at University Worship on Sunday mornings in Perkins Chapel, Dr. Finnin has extended the impact of the chaplaincy across the campus and into the larger community. An Underwood Fellow of The Danforth Foundation, he has served as a member of the boards of directors of The National Institute for Campus Ministries (Boston), Dallas Area Habitat for Humanity, the Greater Dallas Community of Churches, and as president of the board of the Association for College and University Religious Affairs (two consecutive terms). He serves on the board of The Dallas Memorial Center for Holocaust Studies, is a Life Member of the board of the SMU Campus Y, and serves as faculty adviser to SMU's Muslim Student Association and Kappa Sigma fraternity. He has organized and directed projects supported by The National Endowment for the Humanities, The Danforth Foundation, the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry of The United Methodist Church, and other private funding agencies. He is an ordained elder in The United Methodist Church. In 1994 he received the "M" Award for service to the University.

CONFERRING OF HONORARY DEGREES

RON J. ANDERSON, DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

As president and chief executive officer of Dallas County's Parkland Memorial Hospital since 1982, Ron Anderson has provided superb leadership of one of society's most beleaguered and overloaded institutions — the public hospital. Dr. Anderson has guided Parkland through its greatest period of modernization. Under his leadership, Parkland has initiated significant improvements in the quality of patient care, both in that major hospital and in the community clinics that bring health care to patients in their own neighborhoods. A visionary leader at the state and national levels, Dr. Anderson advocated a state law prohibiting private hospitals in Texas from transferring patients to public hospitals solely because they cannot pay for their care. This law, the first of its kind in the United States, was the model for federal legislation extending this patient protection nationwide. Ron Anderson is a master teacher and scholar at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center as well as a practicing physician who embodies the highest standards of compassionate and innovative care. For his accomplishments as a hospital leader, public health reformer, and medical healer, SMU is proud to award Ron Anderson the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

JOHN DESCHNER, DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

John Deschner, Lehman Professor of Christian Doctrine Emeritus, has been a member of this community since 1956 when he assumed teaching responsibilities at Perkins School of Theology after finishing his doctoral work under the direction of Karl Barth at the University of Basel. John Deschner is a catalytic teacher, a conscience of this community, whose best known book is *Wesley's Christology: An Interpretation*. Professor Deschner early identified the cause to which he has devoted his life efforts: the common cause of Christian ecumenism. He served from 1946, when still a student, until 1952 as executive secretary for the national United Student Christian Council. From 1983 to 1991 he was moderator of the Commission on Faith and Order of the World Council of Churches; he chaired the drafting team and presided at the Lima session in 1982 where 120 commissioners from all branches of Christian belief unanimously adopted (without abstentions!) the convergence text on "Baptism, Eucharist, and Ministry," which is the most widely translated and disseminated text in ecumenical history. For his passionate, cogent articulation of the beliefs of Wesley for his students, of Methodism for his church and school, and of Christianity for the world, SMU is honored to award our colleague John Deschner the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

MRS. LYNDON B. JOHNSON, DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

Born Claudia Alta Taylor in 1912, she has become known to the world simply as Lady Bird, a particularly apt name for one so dedicated to restoring her nation's native habitats. Not only during her tenure as America's First Lady but ever since, Mrs. Lyndon Baines Johnson has taught us to cherish America's vast ecological range. Her efforts culminated in the foundation of the National Wildflower Research Center in the Texas Hill Country. Known for the strength of her private reserve and for her reserves of personal strength, she takes particular pride in the passage of the Civil Rights Act by her husband's Administration in 1964. As a regent of the University of Texas from 1970 to 1976, Mrs. Johnson advanced the cause of equal educational opportunity that she shared with President Johnson. A proud partner in the achievements of her husband's presidency, Lady Bird Johnson continues to build a life dedicated to public service and conservation. For her contribution to the American agenda of political reform and human equality,

and for the lasting impact of her work on behalf of environmental quality, SMU is honored to award Lady Bird Johnson the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

IRENE CARSWELL PEDEN, DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

Irene Carswell Peden, professor of electrical engineering at the University of Washington, has paved the way for women engineers in industry and academe. She was the first American woman engineer and scientist to conduct field work in the interior of the Antarctic continent. Her research has contributed significantly to our knowledge of radio propagation and the polar ionosphere, buried antennas, the electromagnetic properties of the ice sheet, and radio propagation over long paths in the polar regions. Professor Peden's accomplishments have been recognized with membership in the National Academy of Engineering and selection as a Fellow of the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers. She received the 1994 Centennial Medal from her undergraduate college, the University of Colorado. Named the National Science Foundation's 1993 Engineer of the Year, Professor Peden also has been inducted into the American Society of Engineering Education Hall of Fame. For her achievements advancing the use of technology to learn about our environment, and for expanding the realm of possibilities envisioned by students of science, especially women, SMU is honored to award Irene Carswell Peden the degree of Doctor of Science, *honoris causa*.

ELIZABETH PERKINS PROTHRO, DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

Elizabeth Perkins Prothro is an alumna and benefactor of SMU whose dedication to education grows out of a lifetime of active commitment to the United Methodist Church. The daughter of Joe and Lois Perkins, she honors her parents by supporting the institution in which they played an instrumental role, the Perkins School of Theology. A student of church and Biblical history, Mrs. Prothro has followed the dictate of the Reformers and John Wesley by going "ad fontes" — to the sources. She has amassed a scholarly collection of Biblical texts focusing on that preeminent period of Biblical criticism, the sixteenth century, and on her particular love, English-language Bibles, and she has placed this collection in our Bridwell Library. Mrs. Prothro has also been an interpreter of the sources through her own work on early Texas Methodism and the history of Bible printing. For her contributions to Texas church history, to Methodism, and to the study of the Bible, SMU is pleased to award Elizabeth Perkins Prothro the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

LOUISE BALLERSTEDT RAGGIO, DOCTOR OF LAWS

The only woman to graduate from SMU's Law School in 1952, Louise Ballerstedt Raggio then worked as Dallas's first female prosecutor. Throughout her distinguished legal career she has been a shrewd advocate for the rights and responsibilities of all people under the law. The first woman elected to the Texas Bar Foundation's Board of Trustees in 1979, she received the Texas Bar Association's President's Award in 1987. It is not only because she is acknowledged as a "first," however, that we honor her: it is because of her notable accomplishments on behalf of women and families — and therefore on behalf of all. Louise Raggio was instrumental in the revision of restrictive laws affecting women and in the passage of the Marital Property Act of 1967, which for the first time allowed married women in Texas to buy or sell property or have credit in their own names. Working with SMU Professor Joseph McKnight, Louise Raggio created the first fully codified set of family laws in the world — the Texas Family Code. For her leadership in advancing women's rights and our nation's laws, SMU is proud to award Louise Ballerstedt Raggio the degree of Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*.
