SOUTHERN METHODIST UNIVERSITY

In 1911, a Methodist education commission made a commitment to establish a major Methodist university in Texas. More than 600 acres of open prairie and \$300,000 pledged by a group of Dallas citizens secured the university for Dallas, and it was chartered as Southern Methodist University. In appreciation of the city's support, the first building to be constructed on the campus was named Dallas Hall. It



remains the centerpiece and symbol of

SMU. When the University opened

in 1915, it consisted of two build-

ings, 706 students, a 35-mem-

ber faculty, and total assets

of \$636,540. The original schools

of SMU were the College of Arts and

Sciences, the School of Theology, and the School of Music.

SMU is owned by the South Central Jurisdiction of the United Methodist Church. The first charge of its founders, however, was that it become a great university, not necessarily a great Methodist university. From its founding, SMU has been nonsectarian in its teaching and committed to the values of academic freedom and open inquiry.

SMU also has maintained a strong partnership with Dallas and has given special consideration to area needs in the development of academic programs. In the 1920s, the first business curriculum was offered in response to a request by the Dallas Chamber of Commerce; the Dallas Bar Association supported establishment of the law school, and a forerunner of the engineering school was established with encouragement from the Dallas Technical Club.

After struggling through its early years and the Depression of the 1930s, SMU experienced a surge of growth after World War II. From the late 1940s to the end of the

1960s, more than half of the current buildings on campus were constructed. SMU's academic stature took on a new dimension when the first Ph.D. programs were instituted in 1957.

Today, Southern Methodist University offers a comprehensive curriculum through Dedman College – the college of humanities and sciences – and five schools: Meadows School of the Arts, Edwin L. Cox School of Business, School of Engineering and Applied Sciences, Perkins School of Theology, and School of Law.

The University offers nearly 70 undergraduate majors, Master's degrees in 42 areas, professional degrees in 18 disciplines, and Ph.D. degrees in 18 fields.

Enrollment for the 1996-97 academic year was 9,464, including 5,362 undergraduate students and 4,102 graduate and professional school students. SMU students come from all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and 95 nations. Over 70 percent of undergraduate students received some form of financial aid in 1996-97. Almost 20 percent of the student body are members of racial minority groups. Nineteen percent of the total student body is United Methodist, 17 percent Roman Catholic. Also represented in the student body are other Protestant denominations and other religions, including Judaism, Greek Orthodox, and Islam.

In addition to preparing students for graduate and professional schools, or more directly for their life's work, the University strives to enhance their social, moral, intellectual, and religious development so that they may lead worthy lives as individuals and citizens of the nation and of the world.



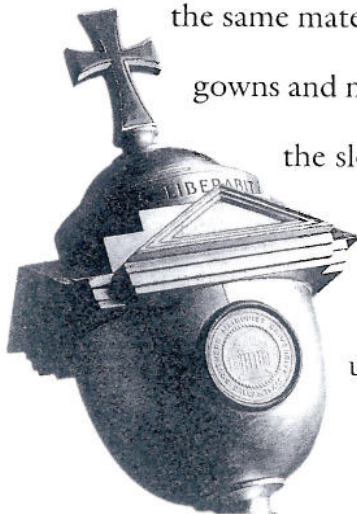
THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION AND REGALIA

The academic procession and the regalia worn by the faculty and officers of the University symbolically represent the continuing link between the modern American university and the founding of the great medieval universities in Europe – chief among them Bologna, Paris, and Oxford. As those institutions were derived from the Catholic Church, the universities adopted many of the ceremonial trappings of the church in their official public functions.

The mace of the University, a symbol of the authority vested in the president by the Board of Trustees and representing the covenant between the president and the faculty, is borne by the president of the Faculty Senate. Though the order of the procession varies from university to university, at Southern Methodist University it proceeds from the chief marshal through the ranks of the faculty and the officers of the University to the president, who is preceded by the mace-bearer.

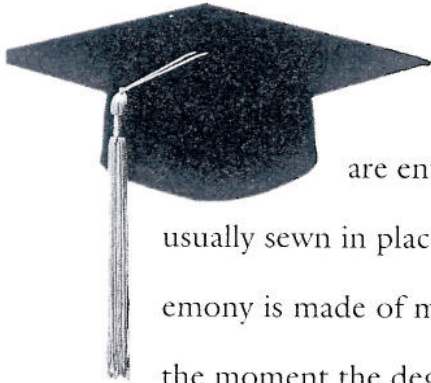
The caps and gowns worn in the procession also vary from place to place. There are variations in design to indicate the degrees held by the wearers, and many universities in America have introduced colorful gowns and other distinguishing details (in place of the customary clerical black from which all originated). The Bachelor's gown is a simple robe falling in straight lines from an elaborate yoke. Its distinguishing characteristic is the long pointed sleeves. Master's gowns are arranged so that the arm emerges from a long sleeve through a slit at the wrist (replacing a former slit at the elbow). In most cases, the Doctor's gown is marked by velvet panels down the front and around the neck, and by three bars of

the same material on the bell-shaped sleeves. It is cut much fuller than the other gowns and may be ornamented in color. Faculty colors are occasionally seen in the sleeve bars and paneling.



The caps, too, vary according to the customs of the university from which the wearer received a degree. While most American universities adopted the “mortarboard” style of Oxford, others have

chosen styles based on other European institutions. The color of the tassel worn with the cap may be black for any degree; or, the color may be that of the faculty of the major field



of learning (e.g. Arts, Engineering, Law, etc.). Persons holding doctoral degrees and governing officials of institutions are entitled to wear tassels of gold metallic thread. Such tassels are usually sewn in place. It is common practice, although not universal, that a ceremony is made of moving the tassel from the right to the left side of the cap at the moment the degree is awarded.

Within the great varieties of styles and colors in gowns and caps, there has been one universally accepted code for the hood worn trailing down the wearer's back. Originally, it was like the hood on the habit worn by monks. Nowadays, the hood through length and color shows the degree and the specialization of the wearer, and the university that granted the degree. The Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctor's hoods are 3 feet, 3 1/2 feet, and 4 feet long, respectively. The velvet trimming in the same order is 2, 3, and 5 inches wide. The color of the trim identifies the faculty. A partial list of faculty colors follows: Arts, Letters, Humanities – White; Music – Pink; Business – Drab; Philosophy – Dark Blue; Engineering – Orange; Science – Golden Yellow; Fine Arts – Brown; Theology – Scarlet; Law – Purple. The lining of the hood – that portion most visible from the rear – indicates the institution awarding the degree. SMU's hood lining, for example, is blue with red chevron.

Through these colorful ceremonies, SMU symbolically displays the continuity of its educational purposes with the origins of organized learning in the Western world.

RETIRING FACULTY

SHIRLEY CORBITT

Shirley Corbitt, associate professor of the Wellness Program (formerly Physical Education), joined SMU in 1963. She received Bachelor of Science and Master's degrees in physical education from North Texas State University and completed a Ph.D. degree and postdoctoral work at Texas Woman's University. Before joining SMU, Professor Corbitt taught in the Dallas Independent School District and at the Texas College of Arts and Industries. She has been active in local, state, and national professional organizations as a keynote speaker and has held numerous leadership positions as the national president of Delta Psi Kappa; chair of the Texas Foundation for Intercollegiate Athletics for Women; district commissioner and vice chair of the Texas Commission on Intercollegiate Athletics for Women; chair of the Texas Division for Girls' and Women's Sports; chair of College Women's Section of the Texas Association for Health, Physical Education and Recreation; and chair of the USVBA Region Nine Executive Committee. During her tenure at SMU, she has served her colleagues in numerous capacities as a member of the Teacher Preparation Council, Faculty Senate, Ethics and Tenure Committee, Judiciary Committee, and as chair of the Department of Physical Education. Professor Corbitt is known for her tireless contributions to civic and social activities. She will retire as associate professor *emerita* of physical education.

MARY ALICE GORDON

Mary Alice Gordon, associate professor of psychology, received a Bachelor of Arts degree from George Washington University, a Master of Arts degree from the University of Pennsylvania, and a Ph.D. degree from Texas Christian University. She joined the SMU faculty in 1968 after a teaching appointment at the University of Texas at Arlington and extensive service in the public and private sectors as a staff psychologist, director of employment testing, personnel research assistant, and psychometrician. Professor Gordon's research interests focus on organizational psychology, and she is the author or co-author of articles published in professional journals, including *The Journal of Forensic Psychology* and *The Journal of Psychology*. She served as the president of the Dallas/Fort Worth Organizational Psychology Group and president of the Dallas Psychological Association. In 1986 Professor Gordon received the Distinguished Psychologist Award from the Dallas Psychological Association. She also has received SMU's prestigious "M" Award for her contributions to the University. Professor Gordon will retire as associate professor *emerita* of psychology.

ROBERT G. HUNTER

Robert G. Hunter, Daisy Deane Frensley Professor of English Literature, completed a Bachelor of Arts at Harvard University and Master of Arts and Ph.D. degrees at Columbia University. He joined the SMU faculty in 1982 after faculty appointments at Dartmouth College and Vanderbilt University. Specializing in the works of William Shakespeare, Professor Hunter published two books, *Shakespeare and the Comedy of Forgiveness* and *Shakespeare and the Mystery of God's Judgments*. Shorter works have appeared in publications that include *Shakespearean Criticism*, *Shakespeare Studies*, and *Southwest Review*. During his

tenure at SMU, Professor Hunter served as the chair of the Department of English, as well as a member on a variety of College and departmental committees. He will retire as the Daisy Deane Frensey Professor *Emeritus* of English Literature.

BETTY J. MAYNARD

Betty J. Maynard, associate professor of sociology, completed a Bachelor of Arts degree at Baylor University, a Master of Arts degree at Stanford University, and a Ph.D. degree at the University of Texas at Austin. She joined the SMU faculty in 1968, and during her 29 years with the University served as president of the Faculty Senate; associate dean for the School of Humanities and Sciences; chair of the Department of Sociology; and director of SMU's Japanese Exchange Program with Kwansai Gakuin University in Osaka, Japan, where she also held a visiting faculty appointment. Professor Maynard's interests include demography, human ecology, social stratification, women's studies, and global society; her works have been published in periodicals that include *Texas Business Review* and *Social Science Quarterly*. She served as president of the Executive Committee of the Southwestern Sociological Association, as well as a member of the American Sociological Association's Task Force on Undergraduate Teaching. Professor Maynard will retire as associate professor *emerita* of sociology.

EDWARD W. POITRAS

Edward W. Poitras, professor of world Christianity, joined Perkins School of Theology in 1990 after serving for 25 years as professor of historical theology at the Methodist Theological Seminary in Seoul, Korea. Born in Massachusetts, Professor Poitras graduated from Yale College with honors in 1953, received a Bachelor of Divinity from Yale Divinity School in 1959, and a Ph.D. from Drew University in 1966. He is an ordained member of the New York Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church. He has published in the areas of missiology and Korean studies, has translated into English several volumes of modern Korean literature, and has published extensively in the Korean language. At Perkins, Professor Poitras has taught courses on the world Christian community and contemporary world theological issues, as well as in missiology and Methodism. He has served as Perkins' international student adviser and is a past president of the Association of Professors of Mission. Before joining SMU, he taught as a visiting professor at the Theological Seminary of the Twin Cities, Candler School of Theology, and Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary. He has served as acting secretary for East Asia of the General Board of Global Ministries and is a member of the Board of the Dallas Peace Center. Professor Poitras and his wife, Genell, a retired social worker at Bryan's House, have been active in Grace United Methodist Church in Dallas. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of world Christianity.

WALTER W. STEELE, JR.

Walter W. Steele, Jr., professor of law, has earned law degrees from SMU and the University of Texas. He joined the SMU faculty in 1969 and has focused on the skills components of being a lawyer. Professor Steele has served as director of the Criminal Clinic and as associate dean for clinical education and has taught courses in legal counseling and interviewing, law

practice management, and criminal law and procedure. His principal teaching and research interest is professional responsibility; he is the author of numerous law review and bar journal articles. Professor Steele has been an active member and adviser to numerous committees of the State Bar of Texas and consults regularly with lawyers and law firms on issues of professional ethics. He served as a special assistant U.S. attorney for the Northern District of Texas from 1985 to 1986 and has been selected to be a fellow of the Texas Bar Foundation. Professor Steele will retire as professor *emeritus* of law.

WILLIAM H. TEDFORD, JR.

William H. Tedford, Jr., professor of psychology, completed a Bachelor of Science degree in physics at Davidson College, a Master of Science degree in physics at the University of Nevada, and Master of Arts and Ph.D. degrees in psychology at Emory University. Professor Tedford's teaching and research interests focus on sensation and perception – particularly time perception – and children's perception of the aging process. He is the author or co-author of approximately 30 articles, which have appeared in periodicals, including *Bulletin of the Psychonomic Society*, *Psychological Reports*, and *Journal of Experimental Psychology*. He has presented his findings to professional groups that include the Psychonomic Society, the Southwestern Psychological Association, and the Texas Psychological Association. While at SMU, Professor Tedford served as acting chair of the Department of Psychology, acting chair of the Department of Physics, and director of the M.A. program in social psychology, as well as a member of numerous University and College committees. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of psychology.

STEPHEN D. WILDER

Stephen Wilder, professor of painting and drawing in the Division of Art, joined Meadows School of the Arts in 1969. He received the Bachelor of Science degree from Purdue University and the Master of Fine Arts in Painting from the University of Wisconsin. Before joining the SMU faculty, Professor Wilder taught at the University of Dallas and at Southern Illinois University, Carbondale. Professor Wilder is primarily known for his narrative and often political figurative painting and for his landscapes of the area around Taos, New Mexico. His works have been exhibited regionally and nationally, including solo exhibitions at Conduit Gallery and 500X in Dallas, Le Mieux Gallery in New Orleans, the Longview Museum and Art Center, and Midland College. Based on his interest in the New Mexico landscape and the rich tradition of painting in the Taos area, Professor Wilder became a guiding force behind the development of the Division of Art's painting program at SMU-in-Taos at the University's Fort Burgwin campus. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of art.

BACCALAUREATE PREACHER

WILLIAM B. ODEN

William B. Oden, a native of McAllen, Texas, is Bishop of The United Methodist Church assigned to the Dallas area. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Oklahoma State University, a Master of Divinity degree from Harvard University, and a Doctor of Theology degree from Boston University. Bishop Oden has served The United Methodist Church in numerous capacities, including delegate to four General Conferences and six Jurisdictional Conferences, leading the Oklahoma clergy delegation in 1984 and 1988. He is president of the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry and serves as chair of the faculty to train new district superintendents and council directors in United Methodism. He also is a member of the Executive Committee of the World Methodist Council and co-chairs the International Dialogue between World Methodism and the World Anglican Church. Before his election to the episcopacy, he served as a pastor in Oklahoma. Conference leadership included chairing the Board of Ordained Ministry and serving as Dean of Ministers' Week. He was a member of the Governor's Blue-Ribbon Commission on Government Reform, co-chairing the Committee on City-State Government Relations. During his last 10 years as a pastor, he was on the faculty of Phillips Graduate Seminary, where he taught courses in preaching, worship, and spiritual formation. He has been a speaker for numerous conferences and lectureships, including Jackson Lecturer at Perkins School of Theology, Visiting Preacher at Boston University School of Theology, and Willson Lecturer at Oklahoma City University. He is a trustee of Southern Methodist University and Southwestern University in Georgetown. Bishop Oden has received honorary doctorates from Oklahoma City University (D.D.) and Centenary College (L.L.D.) in Shreveport, Louisiana.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

RICHARD B. CHENEY

Richard B. Cheney is chair, president, and chief executive officer of Dallas-based Halliburton Company, one of the world's largest diversified energy services, engineering, maintenance, and construction companies. Mr. Cheney, former U.S. Secretary of Defense joined Halliburton Company in 1995, after a long and distinguished career in public service. In 1996 he was appointed to SMU's Board of Trustees. Mr. Cheney earned Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts degrees from the University of Wyoming. In 1969 he joined the Nixon administration and served in a number of positions. He left government in 1973 to become vice president of Bradley, Woods and Company, an investment advisory firm. When Gerald Ford became president in 1974, Mr. Cheney was asked to serve on the transition team and later as deputy assistant to the president. Mr. Cheney later was named assistant to the president and White House chief of staff, a position he held throughout the remainder of the Ford administration. Returning to his home state of Wyoming, Mr. Cheney was elected in 1978 to serve as the state's sole member of the U.S. House of Representatives and was reelected five times. He later served as House minority whip, the second-ranking GOP leader. As secretary of defense from 1989 to 1993, he directed two of the largest military campaigns in recent history –

Operation Just Cause in Panama and Operation Desert Storm in the Middle East. For his leadership in the Gulf War, Mr. Cheney was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom by President George Bush.

CONFERRING OF HONORARY DEGREES

CAROLINE WALKER BYNUM, DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

Caroline Walker Bynum, Morris and Alma Schapiro Professor of History at Columbia University, has remapped our understanding of the Middle Ages with her groundbreaking studies. She has published four major books on such subjects as the maternal, nurturing aspects of Jesus (*Jesus as Mother*); the role of food in late-medieval spirituality and its impact on the spirituality of Europeans, especially women (*Holy Feast and Holy Fast*); *Fragmentation and Redemption*, a collection of essays on the human body, especially its vulnerability to decay; and most recently, *The Resurrection of the Body*, Christian thought and sentiment from St. Paul through Thomas Aquinas. Professor Bynum writes widely on the theory and practice of somatics, the study of the human body, both in itself and as a symbol. One of her most important contributions has been to reconcile late 20th-century theory with traditional modes of historical analysis. Her most recent book was awarded the 1996 Jacques Barzun Prize by the American Philosophical Society for the best work in cultural history. For changing our understanding of history and humanity, SMU is honored to award Caroline Bynum Walker the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

ROBERT CHARLES DAVIDSON, DOCTOR OF ARTS

Contemporary artist Robert Davidson is credited with reviving the artistic tradition of his people, the Haida, a North American indigenous tribe living on islands off the coast of British Columbia. In 1969, when he was only 23, and the Haida culture was on the verge of extinction, Mr. Davidson completed and erected on the site of his family's fishing village a classically carved Haida totem pole, the first of its kind in 90 years. He soon revived other aspects of his culture, including its songs, dances, and storytelling traditions. Today his totem poles are erected in famous sculpture gardens alongside works by Rodin and Henry Moore. His carvings, prints, bronze sculptures, and jewelry have been exhibited throughout Canada, the United States, and Europe. Mr. Davidson has received the Canadian Aboriginal Achievement Award for Art and Culture, along with Canada's highest award, the Companion to the Order of Canada. For his creative achievements as an artist, and his contributions to cultural preservation, SMU is proud to honor Robert Davidson with the degree of Doctor of Arts, *honoris causa*.

ROBERT HEATH DENNARD, DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

U.S. patent number 3,387,286: The ingenuity of Robert Dennard has literally changed the way the world works. In 1967 Dr. Dennard invented dynamic random access memory, now used in every computer in the world. In 1972 he was also among the collaborators who invented field effect transistors, which became the industry standard

for developing silicon transistors. Dr. Dennard is an IBM Fellow at the IBM Thomas J. Watson Research Center in Yorktown Heights, New York, where he has been involved in microelectronics research and development. He is a member of the National Academy of Engineering and a Fellow of the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers, which awarded him its Cleo Brunetti Award in 1982. Among other honors, he has received the National Medal of Technology. In 1954 he earned a Bachelor of Science in electrical engineering and in 1956 a Master of Science in electrical engineering, both from SMU. For his sustained and brilliant work in computer engineering, SMU is proud to honor alumnus Robert Heath Dennard with the degree of Doctor of Science, *honoris causa*.

RUTH HUBBARD, DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

Ruth Hubbard, professor of biology *emerita* at Harvard University, is a widely known scientist and feminist, recognized for her research on visual systems, her work on women's health issues, and her critiques of science. In her recent research, she has addressed the complicated ethical issues of genetic testing and gene therapy. Professor Hubbard left Vienna a few months before the Nazi invasion and came to the United States. A Harvard Ph.D., she began her scholarly work on vision in collaboration with Nobel Prize-winning scientist George Wald during World War II. In the late 1960s, she turned her attention to the status of women in scientific professions. Lately she has focused her critical eye on the fields of genetics and molecular biology. In 1992 she received the American Institute of Biological Sciences Distinguished Service Award. For her achievements on behalf of women and of science, SMU is honored to award Ruth Hubbard the degree of Doctor of Science, *honoris causa*.

THE REVEREND A. CECIL WILLIAMS, DOCTOR OF DIVINITY

Cecil Williams, head pastor of Glide Memorial United Methodist Church in San Francisco, is a passionate and powerful voice for the poor and the outcast. His 6,000-member church in the city's impoverished Tenderloin District is one of America's largest and most diverse congregations. Glide serves more than one million free meals a year, provides drug and alcohol treatment, counsels and supports people with AIDS and HIV, and provides tutoring for children and computer training for adults in the neighborhood. Rev. Williams has been at the forefront of change in America: He joined Martin Luther King, Jr. in the 1963 Freedom March for civil rights in Washington, D.C., was an outspoken supporter of the Black Panther Party, and protested U.S. involvement in Vietnam. The Rev. Williams was one of the first five African American students to pursue work in theology at SMU, from which he took his Bachelor of Divinity degree in 1955. For his mission and stewardship, SMU is proud to honor alumnus Cecil Williams with the degree of Doctor of Divinity, *honoris causa*.
