SOUTHERN METHODIST UNIVERSITY

In 1911, a Methodist education commission made a commitment to establish a major Methodist university in Texas. More than 600 acres of open prairie and \$300,000 pledged by a group of Dallas citizens secured the university for Dallas, and it was chartered as Southern Methodist University. In appreciation of the city's support, the first building to be constructed on the campus was named Dallas Hall. It



remains the centerpiece and symbol of

SMU. When the University opened

in 1915, it consisted of two build-

ings, 706 students, a 35-mem-

ber faculty, and total assets

of \$636,540. The original schools

of SMU were the College of Arts and

Sciences, the School of Theology, and the School of Music.

SMU is owned by the South Central Jurisdiction of the United Methodist Church. The first charge of its founders, however, was that it become a great university, not necessarily a great Methodist university. From its founding, SMU has been nonsectarian in its teaching and committed to the values of academic freedom and open inquiry.

SMU also has maintained a strong partnership with Dallas and has given special consideration to area needs in the development of academic programs. In the 1920s, the first business curriculum was offered in response to a request by the Dallas Chamber of Commerce; the Dallas Bar Association supported establishment of the law school, and a forerunner of the engineering school was established with encouragement from the Dallas Technical Club.

After struggling through its early years and the Depression of the 1930s, SMU experienced a surge of growth after World War II. From the late 1940s to the end of the

1960s, more than half of the current buildings on campus were constructed. SMU's academic stature took on a new dimension when the first Ph.D. programs were instituted in 1957.

Today, Southern Methodist University offers a comprehensive curriculum through Dedman College – the college of humanities and sciences – and five schools: Meadows School of the Arts, Edwin L. Cox School of Business, School of Engineering and Applied Sciences, Perkins School of Theology, and School of Law.

The University offers nearly 70 undergraduate majors, Master's degrees in more than 50 areas, professional degrees in 3 disciplines, and Ph.D. degrees in 19 fields.

Enrollment for the 1997-98 academic year was 9,708, including 5,449 undergraduate students and 4,259 graduate and professional school students. SMU students come from all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and 96 nations. Over 70 percent of undergraduate students received some form of financial aid in 1997-98. Almost 20 percent of the student body are members of racial minority groups. Eighteen percent of the total student body is United Methodist, 17 percent is Roman Catholic. Also represented in the student body are other Protestant denominations and other religions, including Judaism, Buddhism, Greek Orthodoxy, and Islam.

In addition to preparing students for graduate and professional schools, or more directly for their life's work, the University strives to enhance their social, moral, intellectual, and religious development so that they may lead worthy lives as individuals and citizens of the nation and of the world.

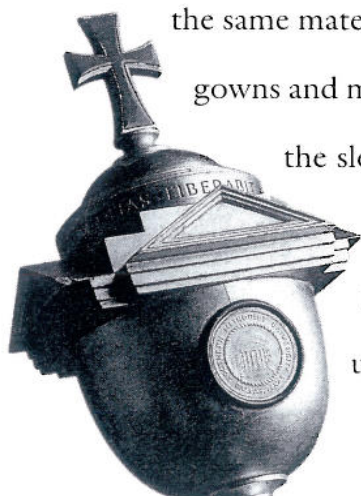


THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION AND REGALIA

The academic procession and the regalia worn by the faculty and officers of the University symbolically represent the continuing link between the modern American university and the founding of the great medieval universities in Europe – chief among them Bologna, Paris, and Oxford. As those institutions were derived from the Catholic Church, the universities adopted many of the ceremonial trappings of the church in their official public functions.

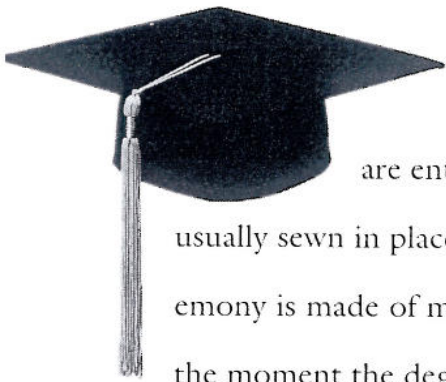
The mace of the University, a symbol of the authority vested in the president by the Board of Trustees and representing the covenant between the president and the faculty, is borne by the president of the Faculty Senate. Though the order of the procession varies from university to university, at Southern Methodist University it proceeds from the chief marshal through the ranks of the faculty and the officers of the University to the president, who is preceded by the mace-bearer.

The caps and gowns worn in the procession also vary from place to place. There are variations in design to indicate the degrees held by the wearers, and many universities in America have introduced colorful gowns and other distinguishing details (in place of the customary clerical black from which all originated). The Bachelor's gown is a simple robe falling in straight lines from an elaborate yoke. Its distinguishing characteristic is the long pointed sleeves. Master's gowns are arranged so that the arm emerges from a long sleeve through a slit at the wrist (replacing a former slit at the elbow). In most cases, the Doctor's gown is marked by velvet panels down the front and around the neck, and by three bars of the same material on the bell-shaped sleeves. It is cut much fuller than the other gowns and may be ornamented in color. Faculty colors are occasionally seen in the sleeve bars and paneling.



The caps, too, vary according to the customs of the university from which the wearer received a degree. While most American universities adopted the “mortarboard” style of Oxford, others have

chosen styles based on other European institutions. The color of the tassel worn with the cap may be black for any degree; or, the color may be that of the faculty of the major field



of learning (e.g. Arts, Engineering, Law, etc.). Persons holding doctoral degrees and governing officials of institutions

are entitled to wear tassels of gold metallic thread. Such tassels are usually sewn in place. It is common practice, although not universal, that a ceremony is made of moving the tassel from the right to the left side of the cap at the moment the degree is awarded.

Within the great varieties of styles and colors in gowns and caps, there has been one universally accepted code for the hood worn trailing down the wearer's back. Originally, it was like the hood on the habit worn by monks. Nowadays, the hood through length and color shows the degree and the specialization of the wearer, and the university that granted the degree. The Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctor's hoods are 3 feet, 3 1/2 feet, and 4 feet long, respectively. The velvet trimming in the same order is 2, 3, and 5 inches wide. The color of the trim identifies the faculty. A partial list of faculty colors follows: Arts, Letters, Humanities – White; Music – Pink; Business – Drab; Philosophy – Dark Blue; Engineering – Orange; Science – Golden Yellow; Fine Arts – Brown; Theology – Scarlet; Law – Purple. The lining of the hood – that portion most visible from the rear – indicates the institution awarding the degree. SMU's hood lining, for example, is blue with red chevron.

Through these colorful ceremonies, SMU symbolically displays the continuity of its educational purposes with the origins of organized learning in the Western world.

RETIRING FACULTY

ROBERT E. BEARD

Robert E. Beard, associate professor of modern dance and composition, joined Meadows School of the Arts in 1967. He earned an M.F.A. in dance from SMU. He trained and performed with leading contemporary artists such as Martha Graham, Merce Cunningham, and Jose Limon. He served as a guest master teacher at the Royal Academy of Dancing in London, the Toronto Dance Theatre, and at universities across the United States. He frequently choreographed mainstage concerts in the Division of Dance and was the artistic director for the Sharp Dance Series. He will retire as associate professor *emeritus* of dance.

ROBERT B. CHAMBERS

Robert B. Chambers, associate professor of theatre design, joined Meadows School of the Arts in 1976. He earned B.F.A. and M.A. degrees from the University of Kansas. Professor Chambers also has taught at the University of Idaho and the University of Texas at Austin. He has designed and supervised more than 70 stage, television, and film productions. He also was active in the review and redesign of the stage design curriculum in the Division of Theatre and was instrumental in introducing computer assisted drafting (CAD) to the stage design program. In addition, Professor Chambers has had an active career as a commercial cartoonist and has written and appeared as an on-camera instructor for a widely used video on gun safety for film and stage. Before starting his academic career, he served as an Air Force officer in Vietnam. He will retire as associate professor *emeritus* of theatre.

VIRGINIA CURREY

Virginia Currey, associate professor of political science in Dedman College, earned A.B. and Ph.D. degrees in political science at State University of Iowa and an M.A. in international affairs at Columbia University. She first taught at SMU in 1954 as an English instructor. She left to study on a Fulbright Fellowship and returned in 1964 as an instructor in political science. Originally a scholar of Soviet-Turkish relations, she later focused on American politics and women's studies. Professor Currey was one of the founders of the Women's Studies program at SMU and was influential in the establishment of groups that include the Women's Caucus of the Southwestern Social Science Association, the National Women's Studies Association, South Central Women's Studies Association, the National Women's Political Caucus, and the Texas Women's Political Caucus. She taught American government, women and politics, government and politics of the Middle East, electoral politics, black politics, issues of American democracy, and political dynamics. She will retire as associate professor *emerita* of political science.

LEROY T. HOWE

Leroy Howe, professor of pastoral theology, earned B.A. and M.A. degrees from the University of Miami, and B.D., M.A., and Ph.D. degrees from Yale University. He joined Perkins School of Theology, in 1969 after serving in pastoral and academic positions in Michigan and Florida. Professor Howe began his teaching career in systematic theology and later shifted to pastoral care. His services to the University have been many, including six years as

associate dean for academic affairs at Perkins and four years as associate provost for faculty and academic programs. He served as Faculty Senate president in 1986-87 and has chaired search committees for the directors of Bridwell Library and Central University Libraries. His unique preparation for connecting pastoral and theological issues has made him an effective teacher and a widely read author, especially in the area of marriage and family counseling. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of pastoral theology.

ROBERT LAURY

Robert Laury, professor of geological sciences, earned a B.A. degree from DePauw University, an M.S. degree from SMU, and a Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin. He joined SMU in 1966. A student of sedimentology and sedimentary petrology, his research has focused on process-oriented sedimentology and applications for solving field or subsurface problems. His work has been featured in such publications as *Journal of Sedimentary Petrology* and *National Geographic Society Research Reports*. He has presented his work to various groups, including the Geological Society of America, Society of Economic Paleontologists and Mineralogists, and the American Quaternary Association. Professor Laury served as director of undergraduate studies for the Department of Geological Sciences for 25 years, director of the Geology Summer Field School for six years, and chaired the combined mathematics and science division for one year. He has been active on numerous committees, including the University Council for General Education, the Fort Burgwin Advisory Council, and the SMU Honor Council. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of geological sciences.

JOHN L. MCCARTHY

John L. McCarthy, professor of biological sciences, earned a B.S. degree in chemistry from the University of Miami and an M.S. degree in biochemistry and a Ph.D. degree in physiology at Purdue University. He joined SMU in 1958. His research, which investigates the mechanisms involving changes in steroid production associated with certain physiological and pathological states, has been published in such journals as *Journal of Steroid Biochemistry*, *Parasite Immunology*, and *Molecular Endocrinology*. Professor McCarthy's work has been presented to the International Congress of Parasitology, the Pan American Congress on Endocrinology, and American Society of Biological Chemists. At SMU he served as chair of the Department of Biology, chair of the department's undergraduate studies committee, and chair of the radiation safety committee. He held appointments as a visiting professor at the University of Edinburgh Medical School and the University of Texas Health Science Center, where he also served as an adjunct professor. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of biological sciences.

DAVID MCHAM

David McHam, professor of journalism in the Center for Communication Arts, earned a B.A. from Baylor University and an M.A. from the Graduate School of Journalism at Columbia University. Before joining Meadows School of the Arts in 1974, he taught at Baylor University for 13 years. Named by the Society of Professional Journalists as its outstanding professor in 1994, Professor McHam taught mass media, media history, and communication

law while directing the communication arts honors program. He received the Meadows Distinguished Teaching Professorship in 1994 for his outstanding teaching accomplishments and the “M” Award in 1980, the most prestigious award given by the University to a member of its community. Professor McHam served as a speaker and committee member for various communication and journalism organizations and worked for several newspapers and magazines including *The Dallas Times Herald* and the Associated Press. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of communication arts.

DARWIN PAYNE

Darwin Payne, professor of journalism in the Center for Communication Arts, earned a B.A. in journalism from the University of Texas at Austin, an M.A. in history from SMU, and a Ph.D. in American civilization from the University of Texas. Since joining Meadows School of the Arts in 1971, he has taught reporting, editing, and history of journalism. Named an Outstanding Professor by the SMU Students’ Association in 1975, Professor Payne is a founding fellow of the DeGolyer Institute of American Studies and past president of the American Studies Association of Texas and served several terms as adviser to the SMU chapters of Sigma Delta Chi and Kappa Tau Alpha. He has served as chairman and committee member of the Texas Institute of Letters’ Stanley Walker Journalism Award. He also directed the SMU-in-London communication arts program. While at SMU, Professor Payne worked at the *Fort Worth Press*, *The Dallas Times Herald*, KERA-TV, and various public relations firms in Dallas. A noted author, he has written several books on Dallas and Texas history and the recollection of reporters who covered the Kennedy assassination. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of communication arts.

JOSEPH TYSON

Joseph Tyson, professor of religious studies, earned B.D. and B.A. degrees at Duke University and S.T.M. and Ph.D. degrees at Union Theological Seminary in New York City. He joined SMU in 1958. A scholar of New Testament studies, particularly the Gospel of Luke and the Book of Acts, Professor Tyson has written or co-authored five books and edited three others. His articles have appeared in such publications as *New Testament Studies*, *Journal of Biblical Literature*, and *Perspectives in Religious Studies*. He twice received the Outstanding Professor Award and last year was the recipient of the University Scholar-Teacher Award. He served on the Faculty Senate for 10 years, including one year as president. He was named assistant dean of Dedman College, chair of the Department of Religious Studies, and director of the Center for the Study of Religion in the Greco-Roman World. Professor Tyson also served as president of the Southwest Region of the American Academy of Religion and the Southwest Commission on Religious Studies and as the director of *Second Century Journal*. He will retire as professor *emeritus* of religious studies.

PATRICIA K. WEBB

Patricia K. Webb, associate professor in the Center for Teacher Preparation, earned a B.S. degree in elementary education, an M.Ed. degree in elementary school administration, and an Ed.D. degree in elementary education, psychology, and early childhood from the University of North Texas. She joined SMU in 1968. She specializes in curriculum development and administration. Professor Webb has written such works as *The Emerging Child*, a textbook on child development, and developed several children's educational toys and activity books. The U.S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare recognized her contributions with its certificate of merit. As chair of the certification committee of Texas Commission on Standards for the Teaching Profession, she helped draft new educational standards for the State of Texas. Over the years, Professor Webb served on committees and advisory boards, including a term as president of the Texas Association of Certification Officers, the SMU Teacher Preparation Council, the Faculty Senate, and the Undergraduate and Graduate Councils of Dedman College. She will retire as associate professor *emerita* of education.

BACCALAUREATE PREACHER

NANCY KASTEN

Rabbi Nancy Kasten, associate chaplain and adjunct professor of Hebrew at SMU, has served as a leader of interfaith exploration within the University community and has helped guide SMU's affirmation of religious as well as ethnic and cultural diversity among the student body, faculty, and staff. Rabbi Kasten, the first woman and rabbi to hold the associate chaplain's position at SMU, helps coordinate the religious life and groups on campus, organized through the Campus Ministry Council. As founding director of the Campus Jewish Network, which established a more prominent identity for the Jewish community at SMU, she has developed and advised three related groups – the Jewish Students Association, the Jewish Law Students Association, and the Jewish Faculty and Staff Association. Rabbi Kasten also has been instrumental in the Chaplain's Office participation in SMU's Wellness Program, developing and coordinating workshops on spiritual wellness. In addition to serving in numerous pastoral and educational settings, she chairs the Subcommittee on Childcare for the President's Commission on the Status of Women at SMU. Before joining SMU in 1990, she was the assistant regional director of the union of American Hebrew Congregations Southwest Council. Rabbi Kasten, who received ordination from the New York campus of Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion in 1990, has served congregations in Santa Rosa, California; New Iberia, Louisiana; and Carrollton, Texas. She received a B.A. degree from Johns Hopkins University and a Master's degree in Hebrew Letters and a Master's degree in Jewish education from Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion in Los Angeles. She is married to Rabbi David Stern of Temple Emanu-El, and they have two children.

CONFERRING OF HONORARY DEGREES

CURTIS WASHINGTON MEADOWS, JR., DOCTOR OF ARTS

Curtis W. Meadows, Jr., civic leader, philanthropist, and attorney, has embodied the highest ideals of intelligent sponsorship throughout his lifetime. From 1978 to 1996, he served as president and director of the Meadows Foundation. In this position, he guided the Foundation's agenda as an organization dedicated to the support of education, social services, health care, civic and religious programs, and especially the arts. During his 18 years as director, the Meadows Foundation dramatically increased its assets while awarding more than \$270 million in gifts and grants. As founder of the Meadows Foundation's Center for Nonprofit Management, he has nurtured nascent philanthropic groups through their critical organizational stages. Curtis Meadows is nationally recognized as a thoughtful, creative, and dynamic civic leader, as well as a theorist of contemporary philanthropy. For his inspired service to the Dallas community and the State of Texas, the University is pleased to confer upon Curtis W. Meadows, Jr., the degree of Doctor of Arts, *honoris causa*.

THE HONORABLE BAREFOOT SANDERS, DOCTOR OF LAWS

The Honorable Barefoot Sanders has devoted much of his professional life to public service, beginning as a member of the Texas Legislature and as U.S. attorney for the Northern District of Texas. Moving to Washington, D.C., he worked as assistant attorney general in the Department of Justice during times of critical decision-making that would influence civil rights and equal opportunity for a changing nation. Appointed federal judge for the Northern District of Texas in 1979, he has demonstrated steadfast loyalty to the ideal of an independent judiciary, showing that impartiality as a jurist can be compatible with previous political involvement. Working with community leaders in Dallas, he maintained uncompromising principles as he directed prolonged efforts to desegregate Dallas Public Schools. For his distinguished career as a judge and his contributions to educational opportunities, Southern Methodist University is honored to confer upon Barefoot Sanders the degree of Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*.

THE HONORABLE ROBERT S. STRAUSS, DOCTOR OF LAWS

The Honorable Robert S. Strauss, public servant, statesman, and attorney, has played a central role in developments that have reshaped the political landscape of the United States and the world. He has served his nation in prominent positions under Republican and Democratic administrations. Under President George Bush, he was U.S. ambassador to the Soviet Union as that nation began its historic transformation, and he continued his service as U.S. ambassador to the Russian Federation. As U.S. special trade representative under President Jimmy Carter, he led multilateral negotiations that resulted in landmark legislation. His achievements as President Carter's representative to the Middle East Peace negotiations earned him the Presidential Medal of Freedom. As an attorney, visiting lecturer at universities, and prolific author, this native Texan has broken ground and opened doors to new perspectives in law, public policy, foreign relations, and global commerce. For his distinguished achievements transcending the boundaries of political parties and nations, and influencing human progress on a global scale, Southern Methodist University is honored to confer upon Robert S. Strauss the degree of Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*.
