- 1. Go to my.SMU enter your ID number and password
- 2. The term is JAN 1261.
- 3. Use the Class Number (the numbers in RED above in the middle column) NOT the Course/Catalog number -

- 5. The results page will let you know whether your course enrollment was successful.
- 6. If you get a message of "errors found," click on that message to read the specific problem. If you cannot resolve the error(s), please contact help@smu.edu. Include your SMU ID number.
