ENROLLMENT GUIDANCE FOR NEW STUDENTS:

Welcome New First Term Counseling Graduate Students!

Following is some information to help you with your first registration:

- If you are a new student, you are required to take the following courses during your first term in the program:
 - 1) Basic Clinical Methods
 - 2) Life Span Development
- If you can only take one course in the first term, you must enroll in Basic Clinical Methods (please note, you will not be eligible for financial aid if you take only one course).
- If you are planning on taking 3 classes (9 credit hours), COUNSELING THEORIES is highly recommended to take in your first semester. RESEARCH DESIGN, FAMILY THERAPY I and ETHICS I are recommended to be taken as close to the start of the program as possible. Other classes can be taken at any time throughout the program (unless there is a pre-req). Good ones to take are: ADULT PSYCHOPATHOLOGY, DIVERSE COMMUNITIES, GROUP or any of your ELECTIVES.

• <u>ALL</u> students entering the Counseling Program in the SPRING 2026 semester are required to attend a Group Advising /Orientation Meeting on Monday, January 12th from 5:30 pm to 9:00 pm. At this meeting, we will review relevant policies, procedures, curriculum, and support resources. Watch for future emails regarding the location of this meeting. If you do not attend this meeting, you will not be able to register for the following semester so please make the necessary arrangements to attend.
