1. Go to [my.SMU](#) enter your ID number and password
2. The term is SUMMER 1254.
3. Use the **Class Number** (the numbers in **ORANGE** above in the middle column)
4. **You must enroll in at least two (2) classes to qualify for financial aid.** Students using financial aid must contact the Financial Aid office.
5. The **results page** will let you know whether your course enrollment was successful.
6. If you get a message of “errors found,” click on that message to read the specific problem. If you cannot resolve the error(s), please contact help@smu.edu. **Include your SMU ID number.**
7. **Familiarize yourself with the Program Calendar and all add/drop deadline dates and refund policies.**
