- Topic of your choice

#### B. Extracurricular and Personal Résumé

To help the Admission Committee better understand and evaluate you as an applicant to SMU, please attach a personal résumé. A suggested format is listed below. Please include your full name and Social Security number on your résumé.

- Extracurricular, Volunteer and Summer Activities List, in order of importance, the extracurricular activities in which you have participated, both at school and in the community. Include any leadership positions and the amount of weekly time involved in your participation.
- Work Experience Include position, company or employer, dates of employment and weekly time involved.
- Honors and Awards List any awards that you have received.

### **SCHOLARSHIP OPTIONS**

SMU offers merit-based scholarships to qualified transfer students. All require a minimum of 50 transferable hours and at least a 3.5 cumulative transferable GPA. Students with a competitive high school profile and less than 30 transferable hours may be eligible for first-year scholarships.

The Phi Theta Kappa scholarship requires completion of an additional form. For all other scholarships, your application for admission to SMU serves as the scholarship application.
