UNDERGRADUATE COUNCIL
February 11, 2000

The Undergraduate Council met on Friday, February 11, 2000, at 9:00 a.m. in 121 Dallas Hall. Present: Dean Kathy Hayes, and Dean O.T. Hargrave (*ex officio*), and Professors David Goodson, Melissa Dowling, David Wilson, Raj Deb, and Wayne Woodward, and student representative, Brett Keyser. Professors Keith Goodnight, Fred Olness and Tony Marks and Assistant to the Dean for Special Projects, Jeanene Anderson were guests.

The meeting was brought to order by Kathy Hayes, Chair of the Undergraduate Council.

Minutes from the January 21, 2000, meeting were corrected and **approved**.

New Course Proposal:

BIOL 3303: *Evolution*

Professor Goodnight was present to represent this course. The Council was supportive of this course being offered. It as a course that is attractive to both Biology majors and non Biology majors. The course was **approved**.

PHYS 3320: *Physics of Music*

Professor Olness attended to represent this course. The course was **approved**.

ANTH 3305: *The "Other" in America: Popular Perceptions and Government Policy through Time*

Professor Marks was present to answer questions regarding this course. Professor Ben Wallace will assist in teaching the course but Professor Marks will consistently be present in the classes. There are many films included in this course and the Council encouraged Professor Marks to require some of them to be seen outside of class time so more time can be devoted to lecture and discussion in class. The course was **approved**.

Internship Guidelines and Proposals

The Council changed the Internship Guidelines to clarify that (1) internships will only be available through approved internship courses; (2) total internship credit which may be applied to a degree is 3 hours (though students can take an additional internship just for the experience); and (3) it was added that students will be required to go to an internship orientation at the Career Center. Dean Hayes plans to look at each internship proposal that has been approved in the Council and make sure that the language is clearly parallel with the guidelines.

Dedman College Academic Majors Current Graduation Requirements:

The Council continued discussing graduation requirements for Dedman College academic majors. It was proposed that the catalog should include the statement, "In addition, Dedman College requires a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 for all courses attempted for completion of a major or minor." The proposal was **approved**.

The Council did not have time to address item #6 on the agenda, "**Discussion to discontinue the joint Dedman/Cox 3+2 BA/MBA program.**" It will be on March's agenda.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:10 a.m.
