HEALTH INSURANCE VERIFICATION FOR PROFESSORS/SCHOLARS SPONSORED BY THEIR HOME GOVERNMENT OR INSTITUTION

SMU J-1 visa holders coming as professors or research scholars are required to have medical insurance for themselves and their families for the entire time they are in the United States.

Failure to maintain health insurance can result in deportation.

For the personal safety of the visitor, a health insurance card containing name and phone number of the insurance company must be carried at all times.

Instructions for insurance company: The following information must be completed and submitted to the International Student & Scholar Services Office at the time of check-in.

_____ 3. Expenses associated with the medical evacuation of the nonimmigrant student to home country in the amount of \$10,000 US.

_____ 4. Deductible not to exceed \$500 per accident or illness.
